

2021 Summer Fun Madison County 4-H



4-H is the youth development program of North Carolina Cooperative Extension. Madison County 4-H offers Summer Fun – a series of educational camps designed to build *life skills* through shared experiences and handson learning. **Youth must be 5 to 18 years of age as of January 1, 2021.** Follow the **3** easy steps to register:

4-H Summer Fun Registration

The following are required, without exception, for 4-H Summer Fun Registration

- **1.** Before Camp Registration: Enroll as 4-H member at v2.4honline.com (includes health form, emergency contact, program liability waiver, and photo release, which covers 4-H membership for the rest of the year).
- 2. Register for camps beginning Friday, May 7th from 5:00-6:30pm, in-person at the Madison County Cooperative Extension Center. Registration will be first-come, first-served and will continue during normal office hours from 8:00-4:30 on weekdays from May 10 June 1 or until camps are full.
- 3. Please bring cash or check payable to Madison County 4-H. Payment for camp fees is due in full at time of registration to cover insurance and supplies. Waitlists do not require payment up front, but will be due if a space opens and you accept.

Participants will learn basic biology, chemistry, physics, and engineering using a variety of common household items and some specialty kits too. Are you ready to be amazed?! Animal Science Institute

Designed for our older 4-H'ers, this week provides an in-depth look at animal science! You will have hands-on opportunities to learn about animal health, anatomy, and nutrition. You will also get to explore careers and take field trips to experience different aspects of the livestock industry both on and off the farm.



Residential 4-H Camp at Betsy-Jeff Penn

Participants travel to Betsy-Jeff Penn 4-H Educational Center in Reidsville to spend the week learning about and enjoying the outdoors! Activities include swimming, canoeing, hiking, horseback riding, archery, climbing wall, and ropes course. The county's Extension 4-H Agent attends with campers to provide a seamless experience — especially for the first time camper! Transportation, meals, lodging, snacks, souvenir t-shirt, instruction, and insurance is provided in the cost. *Payment can be made in installments.



Grilling 101

June 29-30 (Tues-Wed) | 9:00am-1:00pm | Ages 11-18 | \$30

Location: Madison County Extension Center

Learn how to grill all your favorite summertime fare! Youth will get to learn on charcoal and gas grills, and practice selecting and preparing different cuts of meat and seasonal veggies. Participants will learn grill safety and food safety. Wear comfortable clothes for being outside and closed-toe shoes, such as sneakers (NO crocs).

Explore Outdoors

July 6-8 (Tues-Thurs) | 9:00am-12:00pm | Ages 8-13 | \$20

Location: Drop off & Pick up at Madison County Extension Center; Educational programs off-site

Join us on an expedition through the woods and water as we take a closer look at the habitats and wildlife that make the southern Appalachians a biological "hot spot." Wear comfortable clothes and closed-toe shoes for being outside.



Kids as Chefs

From farm to table, participants will learn about local foods while honing their culinary skills! We'll explore foods that are grown locally by making farm visits and talking with growers, then using fresh produce to prepare lunch together! Kids will get to make their own lunch each day, practicing a variety of our chefs' favorite techniques!

Cloverbud Chefs

July 19-22 | 9:00am-12:00pm | Ages 5-8 | \$40 Location: Madison County Extension Center

Learn your way around the kitchen as you are introduced to food safety, knife safety, and kitchen tools. We'll learn how to prepare yummy fruits and veggies that are grown locally. Participants will learn to read and follow recipes while preparing their own lunch each day.

NC 4-H Congress

NC 4-H Congress is a week full of service, learning, and fun! At the state level, participants will get to attend workshops, elect new State Council Officers, and be part of special honor and recognition programs virtually. Here in Madison County, we will have a variety of professional development workshops and recreational outings in-person, possibly even meeting with neighboring counties one day! 4-H'ers who participate in the Presentation Program will be given registration priority, and may receive a discount if funding is available. *NC 4-H will open registration for NC 4-H Congress on May 27, and payment will be due at that point. Registration Policies:

- NO phone, email, fax, or mail-in registration will be accepted.
- All registration fees are non-refundable, unless a class is cancelled.
- Camp spaces will *not* be held without member enrollment at v2.4honline.com.
- Camp spaces will *not* be held without payment.
- Returned checks result in \$30 charge.
- If your child is placed on a waitlist, payment will be due if a space opens and you accept.

Additional Information:

- Space is limited, so once enrolled, your child is expected to attend and participate. If your child can no longer attend, please contact the 4-H Office as soon as possible so we can offer the space to the waitlist.
- Please keep track of which camps your child has registered for. You may receive an email the week before the camp begins, containing additional reminders. Do not rely on this as a reminder.
- Please arrive on time and pick up your children on time. We are unable to wait for late campers when departing for "away" trips, due to schedules established with our volunteers and partnering organizations.
- Due to NC law, 4-H staff are not allowed to supply or install car seats. If a car seat or booster seat is needed, please provide one and place it in the County van. Your child's safety is very important to us!
- If your child will be taking any medication (prescription or over-the-counter) during a 4-H camp, please advise the 4-H staff and supply medication in a labeled container for the leader to be responsible for.
