GENERAL RULES:

1. Youth must be enrolled as 4-H Members at in 4-H Online 2.0 at v2.4honline.com
2. Members must be enrolled in the Dog project by the stated enrollment deadline for the current year.
3. Members can show only one dog per class per year. Each dog may only be shown by one person.
4. Care and training of the dog should be performed by the member who will be showing the dog.
5. If the member mistreats their dog, the leaders will take the following actions: Assist in correcting the behavior. If behavior continues, the member and dog will be excused from the ring.
6. If the dog shows excessive aggression, the leaders will take the following actions: Assist in correcting the behavior. If aggressive behavior continues, the member and dog will be excused from the program for safety reasons.
7. Dogs not being shown must be on leash at all times.
8. To participate in training classes or show at the Madison County 4-H Dog Show, you must have a Dog Health Form on file.
9. Appropriate attire by members is required during all dog training sessions and shows. See 4-H Code of Conduct.
10. Closed toed/heel shoes only (Crocs are NOT acceptable).
11. Only dogs enrolled in the 4-H training program are allowed on the grounds during training times. The only exception will be leaders who use their own dogs for training purposes.
12. All dogs must use a well-fitted slip, buckle or martingale collar made of leather, fabric or chain with NO tags (unless otherwise instructed) + 6ft. leash.
13. All other circumstances will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by the leaders.
