

# 2023 Summer Fun Madison County 4-H



4-H is the youth development program of North Carolina Cooperative Extension. Madison County 4-H offers Summer Fun – a series of educational camps designed to build *life skills* through shared experiences and handson learning. **Youth must be 5 to 18 years of age as of January 1, 2023.** Follow the **3** easy steps to register:

# **4-H Summer Fun Registration**

The following are required, without exception, for 4-H Summer Fun Registration

- **1. BEFORE Camp Registration Opens:** Enroll as 4-H <u>member</u> at **v2.4honline.com** (includes health form, emergency contact, program liability waiver, photo, and transportation release, which covers 4-H membership for the rest of the year).
- 2. REGISTER for camps on Monday, April 24th from 5:30-7:00pm, in-person at the Madison County Cooperative Extension Center. Registration will be first-come, first-served and will continue during normal office hours from 8:00-4:30 on weekdays from April 25 June 1 or until camps are full.
- 3. Please bring cash or check payable to Madison County 4-H. Payment for camp fees is due in full at time of registration to cover insurance and supplies. Waitlists do not require payment up front, but will be due if a space opens and you accept.

#### **Registration Policies:**

- NO phone, email, fax, or mail-in registration will be accepted.
- All registration fees are *non-refundable*, unless a class is cancelled.
- Camp spaces will *not* be held without member enrollment at v2.4honline.com.
- Camp spaces will *not* be held without payment.
- Returned checks result in \$30 charge.
- If your child is placed on a waitlist, payment will be due if a space opens and you accept.

#### Additional Information:

- Space is limited, so once enrolled, your child is expected to attend and participate. If your child can no longer attend, please contact the 4-H Office as soon as possible so we can offer the space to the waitlist.
- Please keep track of which camps your child has registered for. You may receive an email the week before the camp begins, containing additional reminders. Do not rely on this as a reminder.
- Please arrive on time and pick up your children on time. We are unable to wait for late campers when departing for "away" trips, due to schedules established with our volunteers and partnering organizations.
- Due to NC law, 4-H staff are <u>not allowed to supply or install car seats</u>. If a car seat or booster seat is needed, please provide one and place it in the County van. Your child's safety is very important to us!
- If your child will be taking any medication (prescription or over-the-counter) during a 4-H camp, please advise the 4-H staff and supply medication in original container, with authorization form, for the leader to be responsible for.

Before you get your first babysitting job or take on the responsibility of watching younger siblings at home, come learn the basics of babysitting! This two day class will equip you with skills to keep children safe, care for their needs, supervise activities, and respond to emergencies with First Aid and CPR training. You'll also gain business skills to become a babysitting professional, and you'll earn a certificate upon successful completion of the course.

Join us on an expedition up the creek as we take a closer look at the habitats and wildlife of the southern Appalachians! Did you know there is a whole ecosystem in the creek that can tell us about the water quality? We will explore a local creek and learn about the salamanders and macroinvertebrates that live underwater. Wear comfortable clothes and closed-toe shoes for being outside + bring closed toe water shoes.



This camp is for youth who enjoy outdoor activities! Youth will learn target sport safety, how to handle and shoot a bow and arrow, and get lots of practice shooting different targets (equipment provided). We'll also learn about North Carolina wildlife and habitat conservation.
