2024 Madison County Fair

Guidelines for Fair Competitions, Entries, and General Information

Welcome to the 2024 Madison County Fair. If you are interested in entering any of the competitions in either the Adult or Youth division, these guidelines will help you with that process.

FAIR VENDORS

- A limited number of 10' wide by 15' deep Vendor spaces will be available to rent for the fair.
- The fee for each 10' wide space is \$50 which covers the entire fair.
- Fair times are Friday from 3:00 pm to 9:00 pm and Saturday from 11:00 am to 9:00 pm. Vendors are encouraged to set up the entire length of the fair.
- Vendors must declare the nature of their booth as a product, service, etc.
- The fair vendor application is found on the website. Photocopies are also accepted.
- Fair vendor forms are available upon request.
- Two workers per day, per booth.
- No refunds after September 6, 2024.
- NO CHECKS ACCEPTED FOR VENDOR SPACES AFTER SEPTEMBER 19.
- Card payments are also accepted.

COMPETITIONS

General:

- Exhibits are NOT to be picked up before 9:00 pm Saturday. Exhibits may be picked up Saturday, September 28th, at 9:00 pm or Monday, September 30th, 9:00 am 4:00 pm.
- Only one individual may appear on each entry form. For example, if two members of the same family want to enter a competition, they must each fill out a separate form.
- For all entries in the Craft & Agricultural Products Division (including Youth entries), use the general application that lists Departments A through J and YS.
- Entries in the Craft & Agricultural Products Division are open to Madison County residents and the surrounding counties.
- There are separate entry forms for the Youth Livestock Division.
- Each entry form is designed to allow for entry in multiple classes. Simply refer to the specific Department and Class Code listed in the catalog. Be sure to describe the entry where indicated.
- If you desire to enter more classes than a form allows, please use an additional form.
- Deadlines and fees for applications vary among departments. Deadline dates and times are listed in the Division Book for each Division and Department.

Youth Division:

- The Madison County Fair follows the rules and regulations set forth by the North Carolina 4-H Youth Development Program for all competitions in both the Craft & Agricultural Products and Livestock Divisions.
- The Madison County Fair is open to any youth who are at least 5 years old and have not passed their 19th birthday as of January 1, 2024, regardless of 4-H membership. Although 4-H rules and regulations are used, there is no requirement that a youth must join 4-H to participate in the Madison County Fair. These youths simply must agree to follow the guidelines established for the various Divisions and Departments, including age calculations for class levels.
- Youth should use the same form as adults in the Craft & Agricultural Products Division. Note that all Youth classes begin with the letter "Y," regardless of Department.

Youth Premium Schedule: Craft & Agricultural Products Division

- First Place. Blue Ribbon, \$6.00 premium
- Second Place, Red Ribbon, \$4.00 premium
- Third Place, White Ribbon, \$2.00 premium
- No premium is awarded for any youth in the Cloverbud (age 5-7) class. Participation ribbons will be awarded in these classes.

FEES, JUDGING AND DISPLAY

- There are no fees for any Department in the Craft & Agricultural Products Division.
- All entry forms must be received by Friday, September 20, 2024.
- Entry submissions in the Craft & Agricultural Products Division will not be accepted prior to Wednesday, September 25th. Entries must be brought to the Madison County Cooperative Extension Center between 9:00 am 5:00 pm on Wednesday, September 25th, or 9:00 am NOON on Thursday, September 26th (see class-specific guidelines).
- Entries will be displayed at the Madison County Cooperative Extension Center during the Fair.
- Pickup for entries and premiums for winning entries will be Saturday, September 28th at 9:00 pm or Monday, September 30th from 9:00 am-4:00 pm.
- ENTRIES FOR BAKED GOODS MUST BE BROUGHT TO THE MADISON COUNTY COOPERATIVE EXTENSION CENTER ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 23rd BETWEEN 9:00 am 4:00 pm. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER 4:00 pm ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 23rd.
- Refer to the <u>Youth Livestock Division</u> for information regarding fees, deadlines, show dates, and logistical details. These details vary by department. Judging occurs during the scheduled event and awards are made on site.

- All canning entries must be processed according to recognized safe methods found in the current editions of the Ball Blue Book, So Easy To Preserve, or the National Ctr. for Home Food Preservation nchfp.uga.edu.
- All entries must be accompanied by a recipe which includes:
 - o ingredients
 - o amounts
 - o processing method
 - o processing time
 - o **source of processing method** (Ball Blue Book, So Easy to Preserve, or National Center for Home Food Preservation *nchfp.uga.edu*).
- Put the recipe in a small plastic sandwich bag and bring it with you when you bring your entry to the Fair. Put only your recipe title on your jar. Be sure to adjust processing times for altitude. See recipe example below.
- Youth divisions will follow the NC 4-H competition policy. Youth ages 5-18 as of Jan. 1, 2024 are eligible to participate. Youth ages 5-7 may enter the Cloverbud division for exhibition only. Participation ribbons will be awarded to Cloverbuds in compliance with the NC 4-H competition policy. Youth ages 8-18 (as of Jan. 1, 2024) are eligible to compete for awards. Youth ages 8-13 are considered Juniors and youth ages 14-18 are considered Seniors.
